

Dog Licenses



Licenses may be purchased at the Township's Treasurer's office during the winter tax collection months of December, January & February. Proof of rabies vaccine is required. Licenses will expire on the same date that the rabies vaccine was given. Licenses may also be purchased at Mecosta County veterinarians at the time of rabies vaccination.

1 year = \$4.00

3 years = \$10.00

Male/Female

1 year = \$8.00

3 years = \$20.00

Fees for Purchasing Dog Licenses

ONE YEAR:

Unsexed - \$4.00

Sexed - \$8.00

THREE YEARS:

Unsexed - \$10.00

Sexed - \$20.00

Dog Licensing

(Per Michigan Dog Law of 1919, Act 339 of 1919)

1. To be able to purchase a license, you must have **Proof of Rabies** vaccination (**Rabies Certificate**) and to receive the unsexed fee, you must have proof of neuter/spay.
2. It is a law in the State of Michigan that if you have a dog, you **MUST** get that dog licensed.
3. Licensing dogs makes it easier for owners to be reunited with their stray or hurt dog.
4. A license shows that the dog has been vaccinated against rabies, which helps in protecting the community.
5. Dog licenses need to be purchased every year or every 3 years. Licenses cannot be issued beyond a rabies expiration.
6. Dog licenses can be purchased from the Mecosta County Treasurer's Office or any in-county Veterinarians office.
7. Licenses are also available at **some** local townships December 1st thru the last day of February each year.
8. Citations can and will be issued if you fail to purchase a license for your dog.
